

Areas/Start Venues

For exact locations maps of start venues see <http://darkwhitecycling.co.uk/mountain-bike-events/> look out for our black & yellow event signs at each location.

Maps

A bagged, full colour 1:50000 OS map section (approx size A4) pre-marked with all controls will be provided on the start line. One map per rider is included in the entry fee. A master area map can be viewed pre-start. A3 maps (for greater clarity) are also available at an extra cost of £3 per map.

The Challenge

Within the time allowed (2 hours), visit controls in any order and collect as many points as possible - route planning is as important as fitness. Lateness penalties as per standard BMBO rules. Control sites will be identified by bright coloured tape on an obvious feature to which a SPORTident box will be attached. "Dib" in the SPORTident box at the start, finish, all controls visited and the download box at the end. You must use a SPORTident dibber to take part in these events - you may use your own dibber if you have one (please fill in its number on the entry form). If you don't have a dibber we will rent you one automatically. Teams please note: both members must carry and use a dibber.

The Start/Finish

Start times are between 4.30pm & 5.30pm on Round 1 and 5.30pm & 7.00pm on Round 2. Try to arrive at least 30 minutes before your intended start so as to give time to register/prepare. At the start line you will be handed a map with a control description sheet. Hot drinks, juice and biscuits will be available at the finish.

Entry & Results

NO FINAL DETAILS WILL BE SENT OUT. If you wish to have confirmation of a postal entry please enclose an sae. Numbers may well be limited - email info@darkandwhite.co.uk or text 07970 278085 if entering late to check if places are available. Provisional results will be displayed on the day. Results will be posted on the Dark & White website after the events on <http://darkwhitecycling.co.uk/rider-times-results/>

Equipment

A roadworthy mountain bike with good quality/highly visible lights, helmet (ANSI or BSI only - not climbing, caving or canoeing types), watch, relevant map, first aid kit, money for phone calls or a mobile phone, suitable clothing (preferably bright/easily visible) for the prevailing weather conditions including quality waterproofs are compulsory for these night events. Spot checks may be carried out to ensure you comply with these requirements. You should also bring food/drink sufficient for the duration of the event.

Raffle Prize

Rapid Registration

If you have your own SI card and have pre-entered, just turn up, check the dibber number is correct and sign in. No need to queue! No need to stand about. Leave work later!!!!

****Tie breaks: In the event of two competitors in the same class gaining the same score the following tie break rules will decide the winner:

1. The competitor(s) visiting the greatest number of high scoring controls (the greatest and second greatest value controls)
2. The competitor(s) who has/have visited the most checkpoints (and back within the time limit)
3. Earliest starter(s)

If two competitors have the same score at the end of the league the winner will be the one who performs best at the last event.
