

Mountain Bike Orienteering

Mountain bike orienteering is an endurance sport attracting both orienteering and mountain bike enthusiasts.

The Salisbury Mountain Bike Orienteering Score Event is based on an Ordnance Survey Map, 1:25,000. A number of controls with various point values are distributed across the map area & competitors aim to visit as many as possible within the allocated time, either 2 or 3 hours. Each rider accumulates a total score dependant on how many and which particular controls are visited. There is no set order for visiting the controls & riders have to decide the most efficient way in which to use their time and energy. The rider with the highest points total after any time penalty deductions is the winner.



The event start and finish is Summerlands Caravan park, College farm, Combe Bissett, Salisbury SP5 4LP

And held on **Sunday 12th September** Starts between 9.30 and 11.30. Parking in event field with toilets available.

Cost is £9 for adults £5 for youths to enter but to guarantee a map you must pre enter on the BMBO website by 9th September. Entry possible on the day if maps available £12.

E bikes can also enter to visit any area of outstanding Beauty with Panoramic views.

SIAC dibbers will be provided on the day to record your route.
