- Bring your own bike or hire one
- Try it for fun or compete against your friends
- Trophies for Overall and Class Winners

Each rider accumulates a total score dependent on how many and which particular controls they visit. There is no set order for visiting the controls & riders have to decide the most efficient route to use their time and energy.

The rider with the highest points total is the winner. As route choice, level of difficulty and duration of riding are all decisions for the rider, these events really suit everyone whatever your ability level.
