Event Description

Set in the Heart of England this location last featured on the event calendar 3 years ago. The event area straddles both the Stratford and Grand Union canals which provide easy traffic free access to some beautiful countryside between Warwick and Henley in Arden which has many good bridleways which can be linked with canal paths. The area is not blessed with big hills but 90% of the checkpoints will be off road and an optimal clearance will require over 70km of riding and over 800m of ascent!

The event will follow the usual 3 hour format using Sport Ident Electronic timing. An A4 map and checkpoint descriptions will be provided on the day. An indicative Area map without checkpoints will be posted on the Midlands MBO Facebook page before the event.

The event is also being supported by Royal Leamington Spa Cycle Club whose members are assisting on the day.

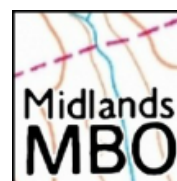
