Areas/Start Venues

Exact venues/locations will be released 1 month before each event – full details will be on the D&W website look out for yellow/black directional road signs at all events. NB: SOME OF THE CAR PARKS MAY BE PAY & DISPLAY.

Maps

A bagged, colour 1:50000 OS map (approx size A4), pre-marked with all controls, will be provided on the start line. One map per entrant is included in the entry fee. Enlarged maps for greater clarity available approx size A3 (£3.00 each). An area Master Map can be viewed pre-start.

The Challenge

Within the time allowed (3 hours), visit controls and collect as many points as possible - route planning is as important as fitness. Lateness penalties as per standard BMBO rules. Control sites will be identified by bright coloured tape on an obvious feature to which a SPORTident box will be attached. "Dib" in the SPORTident box at the Start, Finish, all controls visited and THE DOWNLOAD BOX at the end! You must use a SPORTident dibber to take part in these events; you may use your own dibber if you have one (please fill in its number on the entry form). If you don't have a dibber we will rent you one automatically. Teams please note: both members must carry and use a dibber.

The Start/Finish

Start anytime between 09.00 & 10.30hrs. Try to arrive at least 30 minutes before your intended start to give time to register/prepare. At the start line you will be handed a map and a control description sheet. All courses close 14.30hrs. Hot drinks, orange juice and biscuits will be available at the finish.

Entry & Results

NO FINAL DETAILS WILL BE SENT OUT. If you wish to have confirmation of entry please email us or enclose an sae with your postal entry. Event numbers will be limited so if entering late check the website for availability or text 07970 278085/email info@darkandwhite.co.uk Provisional results will be displayed on the day; full results will be on the Dark & White website after each event.

Equipment

A roadworthy mountain bike, helmet (ANSI or BSI only – not climbing, caving or canoeing types), watch, relevant map, first aid kit, money for phone calls or a mobile phone, substantial clothing including quality waterproofs are compulsory for these events. Spot checks may be carried out to ensure you comply with these requirements. Bring food/drink sufficient for the duration of the event.

Prizes/Class Awards

Class winners and runners up will win a combination of equipment prizes from Purple Harry's, Vertebrate Publishing, Buff and Igloo Cycles (Chesterfield). NB - classes may be merged if entries are low. Prizes will be posted out after the last event once the results are declared final. Rapid Registration

****Tie breaks: In the event of two competitors in the same class gaining the same score the following tie break rules will decide the winner:

- The competitor(s) visiting the greatest number of high scoring controls (the greatest and second greatest value controls)
- 2. The competitor(s) who has/have visited the most checkpoints (and back within the time limit)
- Earliest starter(s)

If two competitors have the same score at the end of the league the winner will be the one who performs best at the last event.
